Year 3 And Their Volatile Volcanoes!



In Year 3, during our geography lessons, we have been learning about volcanoes. The children learnt about the build-up of pressure beneath the earth's surface and what happens throughout the process of a volcanic eruption. In class we talked about what happens to the magma as it reaches the surface through the vent of the volcano, linking to the work we have been doing in science lessons on rocks and how they are formed and change over time.

To demonstrate what happens when pressure builds up, we created a chemical reaction to imitate what it might look like when a volcano erupts due to a build up of pressure beneath the earth's crust. Although this chemical reaction demonstrated clearly what happens when pressure builds, the children were taught explicitly that this isn't a true representation of what happens beneath the earth's surface.
