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## Science in Year 3



In Year 3, we have been looking at different types of teeth and learning about the causes and effects of tooth decay. The children have designed and conducted a scientific investigation that represents what might happen to a tooth if exposed to too much acid or sugar. The children used egg shells to represent a tooth and then placed them in five different liquids (vinegar, water, juice, milk and coca cola) and left them for a week. Each day, we recorded what was happening to the egg and discovered that vinegar decayed the shell the most!
