

Column Addition – Expanded

3 digit to 2 digit

When writing down calculations, separate the numbers into ones, tens, hundreds and thousands.

List the numbers in a column and **ALWAYS** start adding with the ones first.

REMINDER:

Don't forget to carefully add up the totals of each column as sometimes we forget when we have to regroup.
