

L.O. To learn French vocabulary for family members.

1) Watch this video clip to hear a French speaker introduce her family to her English friend:

2) Go to the Willingham Primary School YouTube channel. Watch the video **31.03.20/French/Family Members**. Practise repeating the different phrases in French.

3) Copy out the table below, recording the French and English word for each family member accurately, including any accents.

Pay close attention to the possessive pronouns which mean “my”. In English there is only one word for “my”. In French there is a masculine (**mon**), feminine (**ma**) and plural (**mes**) spelling of this word.

mon père	my father
ma mère	my mother
mes parents	my parents
ma sœur *	my sister
mon frère	my brother
ma grandmère	my grandmother
mon grandpère	my grandfather
mes grandparents	my grandparents
ma famille	my family
je te présente	I present to you
voici	here is

* Look carefully at how the “o” and “e” are linked together as one letter in this word. Copy this accurately.

4) Draw a picture of your family, or cut and stick photographs of each family member on to a piece of paper. Label each family member in French.

Challenge: Can you write any sentences to introduce your family?

For example: **Voici mon frère.** (Here is my brother.)

Je te présente ma sœur. (I present to you my sister.)
