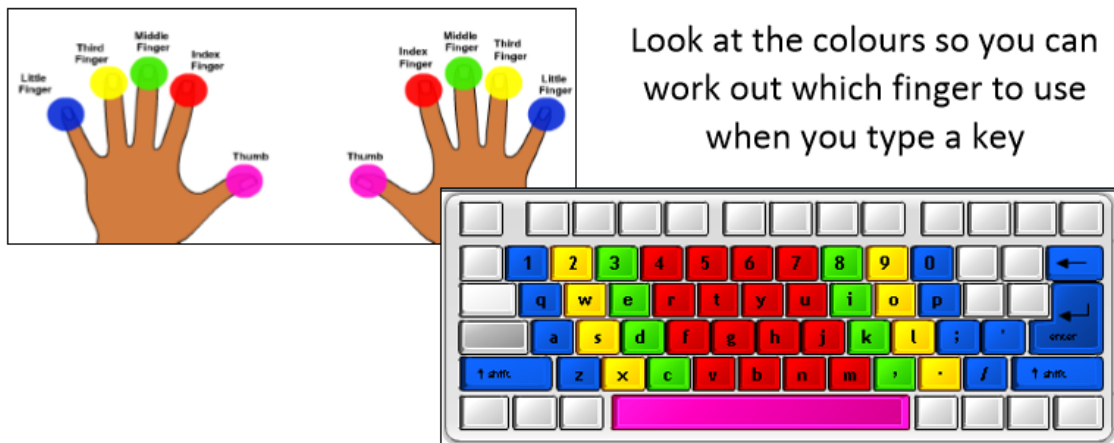


Computing – Touch typing
