<p>Under : below something else eg He hid <u>under</u> bed.</p> <p>Used : put something to a particular purpose eg Horses were <u>used</u> in World War I.</p> <p>Wanted : wished for or needed eg He was a <u>wanted</u> man.</p> <p>Water : a clear liquid needed for animal and plant life eg "Can I have some <u>water</u>, please?"</p> <p>Way : a direction, route or path eg "We'll need to stop on the <u>way</u>."</p>	<p>Mistaken : wrong in someone's opinion eg "I'm sorry but you are <u>mistaken</u> in thinking that."</p> <p>Blackened : made dark or black eg She smiled revealing her <u>blackened</u> teeth.</p> <p>Brightened : become lighter eg The sun <u>brightened</u> up the sky.</p> <p>Flattened : made flat eg He <u>flattened</u> himself against the wall.</p> <p>Straightened : made straight eg I <u>straightened</u> my hair with my new GHDs.</p>	<p>Challenge :</p> <p>Verb - I <u>challenge</u> you to a duel!</p> <p>Noun - She took up the <u>challenge</u>.</p> <p>Benefit :</p> <p>Verb - The law will <u>benefit</u> the country.</p> <p>Noun - Enjoy the <u>benefit</u> of being at home!</p> <p>Function :</p> <p>Verb - My study is going to <u>function</u> as my classroom for a while!</p> <p>Noun - The <u>function</u> of the heart is to pump blood.</p> <p>Influence :</p> <p>Verb - The weather <u>influences</u> my mood.</p> <p>Noun - Her friends were a bad <u>influence</u>.</p> <p>Damage :</p> <p>Verb - The scandal could <u>damage</u> his career.</p>
