

Year 3 Maths - Answers

LO: To solve 1 step word problems using 2 and 3 digit numbers.

1. Yesterday Claire had 145 books. Her sister gave her 45 more.

How many does she have now?

$$145 + 45 = 190 \text{ books}$$

2. Tim scored 223 points on his computer on Monday and 32 on Tuesday. What is his total score?

3. $223 + 32 = 255 \text{ points}$

4. Jack is reading a book. He read 135 pages in the morning and 27 in the afternoon.

How many pages has he read?

$$135 + 27 = 162 \text{ pages}$$

5. Sam walks 145m in the morning and 232m in the afternoon. How far had he walked?

$$145\text{m} + 232\text{m} = 377\text{m}$$

6. Tom had 343 Match-Attax cards. This morning he won another 213 cards from his friend.

How many cards does he have now?

$$343 + 213 = 556 \text{ cards}$$

7. One hotel was 133m wide and the other was 345m wide. How wide were they altogether?

$$133 + 345 = 478\text{m}$$
