1. What is the name of the county town of Suffolk? *Ipswich*
2. In which Lancashire town could you find the Tower Ballroom? *Blackpool*
3. What are the names of the two national parks found in Hampshire? *The New Forest and the South Downs National Park*
4. What kind of mill can you find on the River Deben in Woodbridge, Suffolk? *A tide/mill (harnesses the power of the sea/tide)*
5. In which Lancashire town was the first KFC opened in the UK and in what year? *Preston in 1965*
6. What kind of ships used to dock at Southwold Pier? *Belle steamships*
7. Whose statue can you see in Winchester, Hampshire? *King Alfred the Great*
8. Suffolk is the furthest *east* you can go in the UK.
9. Name 3 of the cotton mill towns in Lancashire listed by Miss C. *Any 3 from Blackburn, Bolton, Burnley, Chorley, Rochdale and Wigan*
10. Where is the smallest pub in Britain and what is it called? *It is in Bury St Edmunds and it is called the Nutshell Pub.*
11. Who is the patron saint of Suffolk? *St. Edmund*
12. How tall is Blackpool Tower and how long does it take to paint it from top to bottom? *138 metres tall, 7 years to paint it from top to bottom*
13. Horse racing has taken place in Newmarket since at least *1147*.
14. Britain's longest canal flows through large parts of Lancashire. What is this canal called? *The Leeds and Liverpool Canal*
15. What roam freely around the New Forest in Hampshire? *Ponies and horses*
