### Plot

#### **Exposition (Opening):**

Time – long ago / during a famine (a famine refers to when there is not enough food for everyone to eat)

Place – cabin in a forest / forest

→ Hansel and Gretel lived with their mother and father.

#### **Rising Action (Build-up):**

→ The children went into the forest with their mother, leaving a trail of stones.

→ They returned home.

→ The children went into the forest with their mother, leaving a trail of breadcrumbs.

→ Their mother left them in the woods.

→ Hansel and Gretel were lost.

→ They discovered a house made of delicious sweets.

#### **Climax (Problem/Dilemma):**

→ The house made of sweets belonged to an evil witch who captured them when they went inside!

→ Hansel was locked up in a cage hanging directly over a boiling pot of water – the witch planned to eat fatten them up and eat them!

#### **Falling Action (Solutions to the problem found):**

→ Gretel tricked the witch into believing there was a dragon outside.

→ Hansel escaped from his cage and pushed the witch into a pot of hot water, melting her.

#### **Resolution (Conclusion):**

→ The children gathered the sacks of gold that the evil witch had stolen from other children.

→ They ran out of the house
