1. Minutes of the last meeting (AGM) and any matters arising (circulate)
No issues raised.

2. Requests for funding

The additional funding requests approved by the WSA included:

- £650 of additional funding for the ITC equipment (wifi booster was already agreed) approved by all

3. Update on opening of the running track and IT touch screens for classrooms

The opening went really well, Holly garnered enthusiasm and inspired the children.

Holly shared a presentation aligned to the school's values. She has been in contact since and we hope to carry on working on with her.

Cecilia Pipe had pulled together an article for the Willingham news. Hope to write a school update article.

There remain some concerns over the running track, some of the corners are tight and the surface is a slightly bumpy. The contractors have been back and looked at it, they are going to come back and fix or review it.

The children have been using it daily and it is encouraging them to exercise more.

Next time we will try and communicate better and raise awareness about what things will look like earlier.

The new Wi-Fi has been received, but not installed yet.

Dave has received positive feedback that the touch screens have transformed teaching for staff.

4. Update on co-op funding



It has been confirmed that we will receive the funding from the co-op this year. We hope to use that for the playground markings.

However, this work won't be completed until next year, as we are not allowed to spend the funding before the round has closed.

To raise awareness, we could run a Facebook poll to get parents to vote on their favourite design.

5. Events discussions:

a. Christmas Raffle

- We have decided on a text raffle with BACS payments
- Prizes We already have a Waitrose hamper and a prize of a meal from the curry house
- We need to agree the theme of the hampers. We need one for each class.
- ACTION Dave to ask the teachers to come up with ideas for hampers.
- Tom Bowran will provide a Beer and Cider Hamper and Ginger Bread houses
- There will be 11 class hampers, a beer and cider hamper, a Waitrose hamper, a gingerbread houses hamper and possibly some more local hampers 15 in total

- Becky will print out some labels for tags.

c. Virtual Elf Visit

- The visit is all booked the books are being sent today.
- The code will be sent for the video to Marie who will forward to the teachers.

d. Wreathmaking

- This is going ahead we have 33 sold and 17 left.
- We are able to sell 50.
- Emma will develop a plan to pull the packs together.
- Dave confirmed we can add the video of how to create the wreaths on the school you tube channel.
- We have a risk assessment for the council completed.

e. Christmas boxes or virtual Christmas fayre

- The WSA agreed that we have a number of events, so we don't need to consider a virtual Christmas fayre.
- We normally buy crackers for the Christmas lunch; we will be able to do this again this year. However, the Christmas lunch will be done over two days.

• We could ask the kitchen to provide a Christmas cookie.

f. Pantomime and theatre visit?

- Dave is in discussion with M&M productions, he is also looking at orchestra's. He is hoping to do something in place of the pantomime.
- We can do a virtual pantomime for the older children. It could be shown on the last day of term as it only lasts an hour.

6. Any other business:

b. Second-hand uniform

Susan is selling via facebook, she has got a lot of stock so will continue to sell this.

c. Christmas card update

There was a larger uptake this year – we raised approximately £500.
