



## Knowledge Organiser for Year 1/2 History The Stone Age

Stone Age	A period of pre-history millions of years ago.
Pre-historic	Pre-historic - a period of time before history was recorded through writing.
BC	B.C - before the birth of Christ.
AD	A.D - Anno Domino (Latin for the year of the Lord) after Christ was born.
Archaeologist	Archaeologist - historians who find out about the past by looking at what people have left behind.
Paleolithic	The early phase of the Stone Age
Mesolithic	The middle part of the Stone Age
Neolithic	The later part of the Stone Age
Evolve/d	To change, develop and get better over a period of time.
Neanderthals	An extinct species of Early Humans
Homo Sapiens	The species to which all modern humans belong to (us).



The blue parts of this map are ice sheets. The dark green shows what the land is like now and the light green is what the land was like at the beginning of the Stone Age. This means that the Early Humans could walk from Africa to Europe!
