3. Treasurers Report: We made £2k profit on our Winter Fayre and Christmas cards. We made £200 on the wreath making event.
We have now received £2,700 into our account from the Co-Op community fund. Agreed that it would be a good idea to spend this on something specific and publicise. Committee to think of ideas for this.

Refund received for the Reception outdoor igloo as it wasn't British weather proof.
